4.	A copy of Certificate of Good Standing from the Colorado Secretary of State.
5.	2019 State of Colorado Business (not personal tax return except where personal tax return is the
	business tax return) Tax Return or a Colorado Tax Exempt Certificate (if opened between Jan 1,
	2020 and March 26, 2020, income statements for all of 2020).
6.	Receipt from most recent payment of Unemployment Insurance Payroll Taxes.
